



## Cuts in Child Care Will Deliver Another Economic Blow to Sacramento

- Child Action, Inc. provides child care subsidies to working parents in Sacramento County who earn over \$ 67 million dollars.
- Over \$78 Million is reimbursed to Sacramento businesses and individuals for child care services provided annually.
- Child Action, Inc. employs 300 people who earn \$14 Million which is spent in the local community.

Loss of these programs would result in :

- \$160 Million lost from the Sacramento economy
- 7500 lost jobs for families using subsidized child care
- 4500 lost jobs in the local child care workforce

On average, for each dollar cut in the child care sector, the broader economic impact is two dollars.

For each job lost in the child care sector the economic impact is 1 1/2 jobs.
